

Dear Family: in class today, we explored how animals move at different levels.

Did you know?

- Different animals move on different levels.
- Some animals crawl. Worms and turtles crawl. They are close to the ground.
- Some animals are on a high level. Giraffes and gazelles have long legs. They move from a place that is higher from the ground.
- Some animals can move on many levels.

Ask your child:

- Explain how different animals move.
- Tell me some animals that move at a middle level.
- Show me how a turtle moves at a low level.
- Show me how a giraffe moves at a high level.

Vocabulary:

- level – height.
- low – close to the ground.
- middle – halfway from each end.
- high – a great distance from the ground.
- limbo bar – a horizontal pole. It is lowered as dancers pass under it.
- leap – to jump in the air across a distance.

Activity:

Place the words high, middle, and low on a yardstick. Help your child find things around your home that match each level. Write a list, and send it to school to share with us.
